AAK Safety

AAK Safetyknife is an emergency knife for one time use.

- Very light weight (22g)
- Extremely efficient cutting of ropes and webbing
- High level of safety - possibility of unwanted cutting is eliminated.
- Cuts ropes up to 12mm diameter
- Very sharp blade in stainless steel, made by Lutz Blades in Germany
- Strong and stiff composite material (black)
- Flexible nylon for the safety guard (red)
- Can be attached to harness or belt loops without carabiner
- When placed on harness, it is ready for cutting within seconds
- One-handed operation - the knife is released and is ready to cut without changing grip
- Quick-release with familiar locking system
- The blade and knife edge is extremely sharp and thin, and is not made for durability. It is made to be as sharp as possible the one time you really need it.



PLACE ON HARNESS:

- Press the red buttons on each side of the knife simultaneously to release the knife from the safety guard.
- The safety guard is flexible and can be carefully bent open and threaded onto a gear loop or a belt loop.
- Attach the knife to the safety guard by pushing the two parts together until they click together.
- The Safetyknife is now ready to be used on short notice. The knife blade is fully protected from unwanted cutting.



USE:

- Grab the knife between thumb and forefinger at the red buttons on each side.
- Press together and release the knife.
- Without changing grip, select the object to be cut by inserting it into the slot.
- Pull the knife toward you.
- The rope or webbing is pressed against the knife edge while sliding inwards in the slot.
- Very quick cutting.
